## LIFE NEWS

#### (+) SC Update

A South Carolina senate subcommittee has removed two exemptions to the fetal heartbeat bill, which would ban abortions after a baby's

heartbeat can be detected. In October, the committee voted in favor of removing the exemptions of rape and incest, leaving medical emergencies as the sole exemption to the ban.

#### (-) More Opposition

The pro-abortion Center for Reproductive Rights has recently established a "Creative Council" made up of women in Hollywood and the fashion industry in order to "destigmatize abortion by sharing and supporting women's stories." Their agenda includes using the platforms of these highly visible and vocal women to propagate "reproductive rights stories." At the head of this new initiative: actress/director/producer Elizabeth Banks. Be sure to miss her productions!

#### (+) Lower Incidence Rate

According to the Associated Press, the number and rate of abortions in the U.S. are at their lowest rates since they became legal in 1973. The decline is attributed in part to fewer women becoming pregnant.

#### (-) AL Update

A federal judge has ruled that Alabama may not enforce its law protecting unborn babies from abortion. Abortion activists sued the state over Alabama's abortion ban, which was slated to go into effect November 15, and U.S. District Court Judge Myron Thompson issued a preliminary injunction against the ban.
